State Labor Poster and Notice Requirements

Because You're Different

This document provides direct links to the workplace posters employers are required to display under federal law. These posters, including official translated versions, are created and updated by government agencies. Employers must also comply with all applicable state posting requirements. Employers must display required posters in a public place where employees can easily access them. While most posters apply to all employers, some may apply to specific industries or employers of a certain size. Employers can review each poster description to determine whether they are required to display that particular poster.

ALL EMPLOYERS

The following posters are required for all Nebraska employers:

CERTAIN EMPLOYERS

The following posters are required for certain Nebraska.

Hours of Employment (for Minors 14 and 15 Years of Age)

Required for employers that employ minors under the age of 16. <u>English</u>

Human Trafficking Informational Poster

Required for rest stops, strip clubs and casinos. Voluntarily available to high schools, postsecondary educational institutions, gas stations, hotels, hospitals, health care clinics, urgent care centers, airports, train stations, and bus stations. Available by calling (402) 471-2239.
