#### Easy to Use

Injured associates connect from Triage or on-site clinics, starting on a telephone and seamlessly transitioning to the video experience.

### **Process Support**

Medcor's Patient Care Navigators (PCNs) support both injured associates and physicians to & through the visit, and after:

- Connect the associate to Medcor Telemed platform and physicians, or if unable to connect, channel to designated clinic-based providers.
- Introduce the case and orient the physicians to Medcor protocols and template.
- Memorialize key data points after reviewing the orders and return to work restrictions with physicians and Walmart associate.
- Manage the referral process, including First Fill, PT, DME, imaging and referrals of complex cases to clients' designated network providers.
